The Monroe County Energy Challenge (MCEC) seeks individuals from across the community to act as Energy Ambassadors in neighborhoods, workplaces, faith communities, and other subpopulations as part of the local effort to reduce energy use.

Duties:

Energy Ambassadors will act as active connectors between the Challenge and Monroe County's diverse populations and geographic areas.

Ambassadors will:

- Participate in a half-day training covering the details of the Challenge effort, basic energy efficiency facts and techniques, and outreach strategies
- Commit to 20-40 hours of volunteer work per month in support of the Challenge
- In partnership with the MCEC Engagement Committee, develop an outreach strategy for a target population
- Coordinate activities with the EnergyMobile, an energy-efficient vehicle that will travel to neighborhoods throughout the county to share energy efficiency materials, information and provide technical assistance to local residents

Skills and interests desired:

- A genuine interest in helping Monroe County residents save energy
- Willingness to think creatively about outreach strategies for a specific sub-population, organization, or geographic area within the county
- Ability to communicate effectively in diverse contexts
- Basic knowledge of energy issues is helpful but not required
- Ability to work under minimal supervision
